We do not pass the offering plates, but if you want to give we ask you to bring your gifts and leave them in the offering plates on the altar.

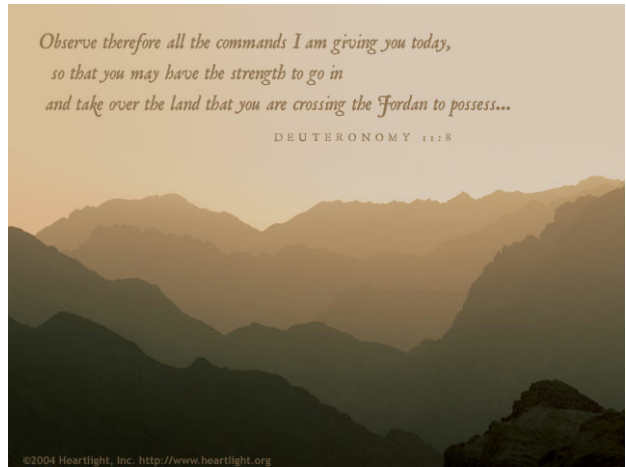
